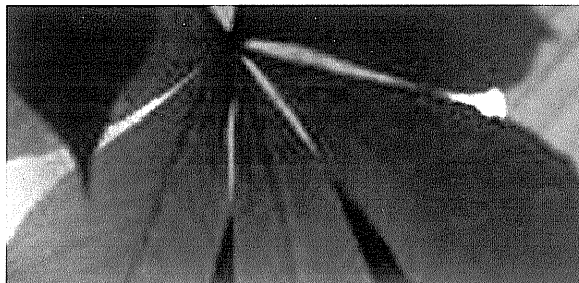
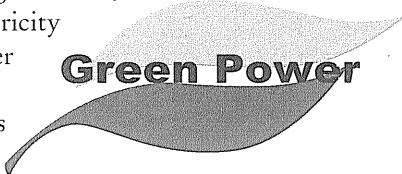
We invite you to say yes.

What is Green Power? Green Power is energy that comes from wind, solar, water, organic materials and more. Renewable sources replenish themselves naturally, leading to significant reductions in waste and emissions and improved air and water quality.

How I Make a Difference Your purchase of green power puts electricity generated from renewable sources on the electric grid in place of electricity from traditional power plants. For a residential customer, only one block of green power each month for a year is equivalent to saving 86 gallons of gasoline, keeping 1,800 pounds of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere or planting an acre of mature trees. Plus, when you create demand for cleaner electricity, you encourage further development on new cleaner sources of energy.

To make sure we keep our commitment to you, the Center for Resource Solutions, an independent nonprofit organization, verifies that electricity from green power sources equal to your purchases is delivered to the electric grid.

We receive a Green E-certification from this center.



The Cost

While renewable resources, such as sunlight may be free, the technology used to capture it remains more expensive than traditional methods. Consequently, there is a premium for renewable energy. Hopefully, over time, increased demand will lower costs.

Participation is Simple

Choosing renewable is easy and voluntary. To sign up, simply decide how many blocks of green power you want to purchase. You may stop the program at any time.

For Residential Customers

Purchase one block or as many as you like in increments of 100 kilowatt-hours. Each block adds \$2.50 a month to your electric bill.

For Other/Commercial Customers

Businesses are asked to buy a 5 block or 25 block minimum, depending on your type of service.
