



# Filming 101

## *in East Point*

### *Quick Facts/Information*

#### *For Property Owners, Businesses & Residents*

- **Register Your Property as a Filming Location** Property owners can register their property as a potential location on the State film office site found here: <https://www.georgia.org/industries/film-entertainment/georgia-film-tv-production/list-your-property-as-a-film-location>. Be sure to include your best contact information, a good description of the property, including high quality photos. This link can also be found on the City's Camera Ready page (accessible from the City's home page ([www.eastpointcity.org](http://www.eastpointcity.org)) under the "About" tab at the top left, then under "Camera Ready City", also found here: <http://www.eastpointcity.org/about/camera-ready-city/>. Send the Camera Ready contact (info below) an email as well with your property information (no more than 5MB per email).
- **Register Your Business for Filming Support Services, or Your Property as Lodging** Businesses or individuals catering to the film industry service needs, or property owners offering lodging, can register on the State Film Office site under the "Reel Crew" Production Directory: <https://www.georgia.org/reel-crew-production-directory>. After registering, please send an email with your information and what you are offering the film industry to the Camera Ready contact (info below).
- **If Selected, be Considerate of Your Fellow Neighbors (Residents and Businesses)** Businesses or residents hosting filming at their location should consider reaching out to their fellow neighbors, especially if those neighbors will be affected (ex: road closure, parking restrictions, etc.). The film company is required to do outreach too, but a heads-up from a fellow neighbor first, which can be as simple as notifying your neighborhood association to send out a notice or just walking next door, can help prevent misinformation or misunderstanding leading to tension long after the film production has left. Consider what communication/notice you would like to receive if your neighbor was, instead, the one hosting a film production next to your house or place of business. A little communication goes a long way!
