

RECYCLING

- To obtain a recycling bin, please call: (404) 270-7140.
- Pickup for recycles are scheduled bi-weekly on the solid waste collection day.
- Citizens who wish to recycle cardboard, magazines, and plastic bottles can do so by taking items to the East Point Transfer Station located at 3125 South Martin Street for free of charge. Hours of operation are Mondays thru Fridays 8:00 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. and Saturdays 8:00 A.M. to Noon. No Commercial vehicles/trailers are allowed to dump for free. (i.e U-haul, Hertz, or Penzkie 10ft or more sized trucks)

- Aluminum cans
- Steel cans

- Cardboard
- Plastic water bottles and jugs
- Phone Books

DEAD ANIMAL COLLECTION

- Must be placed in a plastic bag at curbside for pickup.

GARBAGE/TRASH PICKUP

- All refuse containers are to be placed at curbside on collection day no later than 7:30 A.M. Containers must be removed by dawn of the next day.
- A bulk waste fee will be charged for extra refuse located outside of containers. Additional containers are available for \$6 extra per month. If containers are lost or stolen citizens must go to customer service to purchase a new one for \$60.
- Paper, cans and other typical household garbage are considered refuse, and can be placed in the refuse container.
- According to the City Ordinance, all refuse **MUST** be placed in plastic bags and placed in the refused container for collection.
- Please do not park within 5 feet of refuse containers. Do not place containers within 5 feet of mailboxes or other structures on collection day. If your container is blocked there will be a **return trip charge** of \$35.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED

- Dirt/Rock/Sod
- Branches/tree trimming
- Metals
- Appliances
- Furniture
- Flammable material
- Oil
- Gas
- Paint
- Concrete
- Hot Ashes/Coals
- Construction debris
- Remodeling debris
- Demolition debris
- Tires

YARD WASTE PICK-UP

- Tree trimmings **must be no more than 5 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter, and containerized.**
- Grass clippings and leaves **must be bagged in brown paper bags, cardboard boxes or containerized in a rubber or metal container no larger than 45 gals, and weigh 50 lbs. or less.**
- **During leaf vacuum collection season (Oct. 1st thru March 1st) leaves can be placed behind the curb for leaf vacuum collection.**
- Collection of tree trimmings larger than 5 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter and will have a minimal cost of \$50.00, and \$10.00 per cubic yard thereafter.

BULK PICK-UP

- Items such as sofas, chairs, tables, desks, mattresses, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, stoves, etc. are considered bulk trash.
- Refrigerators must have Freon removed prior to disposal.
- Lawnmowers must have gasoline, and oil removed prior to disposal.
- The cost for bulk trash collection is \$35.00 for the first item, and \$10.00 for each additional item.
- You must call the Solid Waste Services Division to schedule pick-up.
