

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of East Point has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes of 8.33 percent, due to property values increasing. Even though the City is proposing to reduce the millage rate to 13.00 mills, the increase in values results in a property tax increase.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall Building, 2757 East Point Street East Point, GA. 30344 on August 15, 2022 @ 6:30 p.m.

Times of additional public hearings on this tax increase will be virtual and streamed online September 6, 2022 @ 6:30pm and September 19, 2022 @ 6:30pm.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 13.00 mills, an increase of 8.33%. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 12.00 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$113,746.50 is approximately \$34.97.
