East Point City Council has entered into a development agreement with **Mynd Match Development Group of Atlanta, LLC** to revitalize East Point's **Downtown Commons**.



The \$111 million development known as "The Commons" will sit on an approximately nine-acre site that will include commercial, retail, residential, green space and public art, according to an announcement this week.
