GARBAGE/TRASH PICKUP

- All refuse containers are to be placed at curbside on collection day no later than 7:30 A.M.
- A bulk waste fee will be charged for additional refuse located outside of containers. Extra containers are available for a fee.
- Paper, cans and other typical household garbage are considered refuse, and can be placed in the refuse container.
- According to the City Ordinance, all refuse should be bagged, and placed in the refused container for collection.
- Please do not park within five feet of refuse containers. Do not place containers in proximity to mailboxes or other structures on collection day.

- Branches/tree trimming
- Metals
- Sod
- Rock
- Appliances
- Furniture
- Flammable material
- Oil
- Gas
- Paint
- Concrete
- Hot Ashes/Coals

YARD WASTE PICK-UP

- Tree trimmings must be no more than 5 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter, and containerized.
- Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged in brown paper bags, cardboard boxes or containerized in a rubber or metal container no larger than 45 gals, and weigh 50 lbs. or less.
- Leaf vacuum collection please call Public Works @ 404-270-7116
- Collection of tree trimmings larger than 5 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter will have a minimal cost of \$50.00, and \$10.00 per cubic yard thereafter.

BULK PICK-UP

- Items such as sofas, chairs, tables, desks, mattresses, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, stoves, etc. are considered bulk trash.
- Refrigerators must have Freon removed prior to disposal.
- Lawnmowers must have gasoline, and oil removed prior to disposal.
- The cost for bulk trash collection is \$35.00 for the first item, and \$10.00 for each additional item.
- You must call the Solid Waste Services Division to schedule pick-up.
