**Leaf Vacuum/Collection Program Will Be Delayed Until Further Notice**

**Important Ordinance Notice**

The ordinance that reflects the requirements for leaf vacuum and collection was approved by Mayor and Council on October 19, 2015.

**About the Program**


**The 2023-2024 leaf vacuum/collection program will be delayed until further notice.**

- The program has not reduced the leaf accumulation in the street and has directly contributed to migrated leaves into the storm drain and eventually clogs storm drains.
- The five leaf vac trucks were purchased in 2016 are aging and the wear and tear of the trucks reduces the efficiency to collect the leaves.
- Additional purchase of leaf vac trucks will be required to maintain an adequate level of service.
- Staffing issues have been a concern with the hiring of the Seasonal Leaf Vacuum Drivers.

**NOTE:** Yard Trash that is collected by the Sanitation Department, which includes tree trimmings and twigs **must be** bagged, bundled, or containerized **year-round and must not exceed 50 pounds** per parcel.
