Greetings East Point Resident,

**Fall is upon us!** The colorful leaves are creating beautiful landscapes but will eventually fall to the ground. Don't worry, the East Point Public Works Department in coordination with the Solid Waste Department is prepared to assist you with leaf collection. There are a few simple instructions to be followed to ensure the program runs efficiently throughout the season.

- Leaves must preferably be placed in a container or bagged. Weight **shall not** exceed fifty (50-lbs) pounds.
- An <u>unlimited</u> number of containerized or bagged leaves is permissible.
- Solid Waste will collect leaves that have been placed in bags or containers on the **same day** as the regular garbage collection day.
- Leaves that are swept to the curb will be collected within forty-eight (48) hours of the regular garbage collection day. Leaves <u>must not</u> be piled on the sidewalk or in the street to prevent infiltration of the stormwater system.
- Failure to comply with the Leaf Vacuum/Collection Program may result in issuance of a *Notice of Violation* and citation.
